Upon a member receiving an Absentee Ballot, he/she shall mark same and enclose it in the smaller envelope marked "OFFICIAL BALLOT." The envelope shall then be placed in the larger envelope and mailed to the Election Board in time to be received before the polls are closed on Election Day. A member receiving an Absentee Ballot shall not be permitted to vote in person at the Election unless he/she has first returned the Absentee Ballot, unmarked, to the Election Judge.

Absentee ballots received at the post office box after 9:00 a.m. on May 6, 2023, will not be counted.
