### OFFICIAL NOTICE OF NOMINATIONS AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Dear Member:

The Nomination of Officers of Local 103 IBEW, will be held at a Special Meeting on **Tuesday, April 4, 2023**, beginning at 5:00 p.m., at the Union Hall located at 256 Freeport Street, Dorchester, MA. The following officers are to be nominated:


- President/Trustee/MA AFL-CIO Convention Delegate
  - Vice President
  - Recording Secretary
  - Treasurer
  - Business Manager/Financial Secretary/Trustee/MA AFL-CIO Convention Delegate
  - Executive Board (6)
  - Examining Board (5)
  - MA AFL-CIO Convention Delegate (9)
- All candidates must be in good standing between the time of nomination and installation, and if elected, must remain in good standing while serving in office.
  - No member shall be eligible for office unless he/she has been a member of Local 103, in continuous good standing, for at least two (2) years immediately prior to nomination.
  - All apprentices shall be given the right to voice and vote for officers at the Local Union Election but are ineligible to run, unless Article XV, Section 14, of the IBEW Constitution applies.
  - All candidates shall be nominated orally from the floor at the above-mentioned Union Meeting.
  - No member shall be nominated for office unless he/she is present or signifies his/her willingness to run for office in writing.
  - No member may be a candidate for more than one office. Anyone nominated to more than one office must choose the office for which they will be a candidate.

Members in good standing and qualified to vote, who expect to be unable to visit the polls on Election Day, may, at any time after nominations, but before 12:00 noon on May 1, 2023, make an application in writing to the Election Judge for an Absentee Ballot. Any such qualified applicant shall be furnished with an "OFFICIAL BALLOT" and two (2) envelopes. One envelope shall be smaller in size and shall be marked only with the words, "OFFICIAL BALLOT." The larger envelope shall contain a space in the upper left-hand corner where the member must place his/her name and address.

The Election shall be held on **Saturday, May 6, 2023**, at the Union Hall. Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Tabulation of ballots will be performed promptly after the polls close.

In the event of a Run-Off Election, the election and counting of ballots shall be held on Saturday, May 27, 2023, at the Union Hall. Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
